



APPLICATION FOR READMISSION

All application materials must be on file in the Registrar's Office at least 10 business days prior to the start of the term.

Returning Students - Any previously enrolled student wishing to return to Loras to complete his/her bachelor's degree and who has been away from Loras College for more than one semester must apply for readmission. Students participating in a Loras approved foreign study semester are not required to apply for readmission.

Returning students must submit the following materials to the Registrar's Office, Mail #1, 1450 Alta Vista Street, Dubuque, IA 52001:

- 1. A completed Loras College Application for Readmission
2. Official academic transcript(s) from each college/university attended since withdrawal from Loras
3. Personal statement addressing the reasons for seeking readmission

Returning student applications will be considered by the Admissions Committee when appropriate. Previous admission is not a guarantee of readmission. In select cases, the student may be asked to provide additional information or to schedule a personal interview.

Students who have been away from the college for more than four (4) years are responsible for completing the general education requirements in place at the time of readmission.
