To use the IRS Data Retrieval process to transfer tax information (preferred method):

1. *The student and/or parent must log in to the student’s processed 2023-2024 FAFSA.*
2. *Click on the “Financial Information” tab in the top navigation menu, and answer the questions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval.*
3. *If eligible, enter the parent’s FSA ID and click the blue “LINK TO IRS” button.*
4. *You will be asked to input your tax filing status and address to verify your identity. Please input your address exactly as it appears on your filed tax return. This includes using all caps if that is how your name and address were entered on your taxes.*
5. *Once your identity is confirmed, select “Transfer Now” and follow the on-screen instructions to submit the FAFSA update. FAFSA updates should be received by the Financial Aid Office within 2-3 business days.*

E. CERTIFICATION AND SIGNATURES: Each person signing below certifies that all the information reported is complete and correct. The student and one parent whose information was reported on the FAFSA must sign and date. If you purposely give false or misleading information, you may be fined, sent to prison, or both.
